Y.E.S. for Dine' Bikeyah (commonly referred to as NavajoYES), would like to submit this request for support from Navajo County for youth programs that we provide to primarily Native American youth across the County in Districts 1 and 2, which includes, to name a few, the communities of Kayenta, Shonto, Chlchinbeto, Black Mesa, Pinon and elsewhere.

Since 1994, we have been offering outdoor adventure programs, school-based events and meaningful community service for youth on the reservation. Our programs reach out to youth, families and schools across the Nation in an effort to provide a more positive and hopeful future. Our Tour de Rez program, which will celebrate 25 years of service to Dine' youth in 2015, extends each summer across the reservation, providing nearly two months of outdoor adventure, education and service. The Chuska Challenge bike event each autumn has become a Navajo Nation tradition. Throughout the year and across the Navajo communities of Navajo County, our programs impact hundreds of youth and families each year.

With the vast space and distances across Navajo County, one of our greatest challenges is improving our methods of transportation. Working with schools and communities spread hundreds of miles across the County, we need improved access to better transportation for our youth outings, service projects and community events.

Our request of Navajo County at this time is for a van that could provide the needed transportation for students involved in our programs. A 4 x 4 van with capacity of 12 people would be ideal for our needs and would make it possible to enhance our services to youth. A 12-foot trailer would be an additional item that could serve as very useful purpose, particularly on our mountain bike outings with youth.

This is in response to your request of December 7, 2005, regarding your organization's tax-exempt status.


