MARCH 10, 2015 “DAY OF THE SNOWFLAKE LOBOS”**

WHEREAS, in front of a heavily partisan Snowflake crowd in one of the most exciting games in the history of Arizona high school basketball, the Snowflake Lobos rallied to win the Division III Championship game by a score of 57-52 against San Tan Valley Combs at Gila River Arena in Glendale on Saturday, February 28, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Snowflake Lobos took its first lead of the game at 46-45 with 3:20 left in the game; and

WHEREAS, the Snowflake Lobos came from behind to win every one of its final three games of the state tournament and captured the school’s first boys basketball state title since 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors recognizes excellence and dedication by the coaches, parents, faculty, community and all the members of the entire team; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors is committed to the development and recognition of outstanding achievement in scholastics and athletics in our local communities.
