**JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND
THE WHITE MOUNTAIN TRIBAL COUNCIL TO SUPPORT JOB DEVELOPMENT
IN NAVAJO COUNTY**

WHEREAS, it is commonly known that there is a critical need for employment opportunities within Navajo County, including on the White Mountain Apache Reservation; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Navajo County Board of Supervisors and the White Mountain Apache tribe to support job development in Navajo County, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, it is understood that computer programming and software development jobs are frequently outsourced outside of the United States; and

WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache Software has been incorporated as a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation, with its primary mission to teach computer programming and software development on the White Mountain Apache Reservation and to develop demonstration projects, and

WHEREAS, the Sales Force Foundation has embraced White Mountain Apache Software for the teaching and promotion of its cloud-based software platform, and

WHEREAS, the students of White Mountain Apache Software have created the website www.LearningApache.com, which has created an enthusiastic response; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Navajo County Board of Supervisors and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

- 1.) Job training agencies within Navajo County and on the White Mountain Apache tribe are encouraged to support the development of a computer programming and software development industry in Navajo County and on the White Mountain Apache Reservation;
- 2.) That institutions of learning within Navajo County and on the White Mountain Apache Reservation are encouraged to provide educational opportunities in support of the development of a computer programming and software development industry in Navajo County and on the White Mountain Apache Reservation;
- 3.) That the departments and agencies of the County, tribal government, and federal government are encouraged where allowed by law, when consistent with existing and binding procurement policies, and when otherwise appropriate, to consider

sourcing appropriate computer programming and software development projects within Navajo County and on the White Mountain Apache Reservation when local alternatives exist;

- 4.) The Navajo County Board of Supervisors and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council request and encourage their Congressional Representative to coordinate the efforts of federal agencies in this endeavor.
