

NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' MINUTES
Tuesday, June 2, 2015

SPECIAL MEETING

PRESENT: Steve Williams, Supervisor; Jesse Thompson, Supervisor; Jason E. Whiting, Vice-Chairman; Dawnafe Whitesinger, Chairwoman were present telephonically. Robert K. Black, Jr., Supervisor was absent.

Call To Order: At 9:01 a.m. **Chairwoman Whitesinger** called the meeting to order.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS: Consideration and possible adoption of **Resolution Number 17-15**, supporting the continued operation of the Apache Railway Company: **Supervisor Whiting** indicated the Apache Railway Company based in Snowflake, operates a short line railroad. He reported that the continued operation of the Railroad is essential to the economy of Navajo County, employment and prospects for economic development. **Supervisor Whiting** indicated the Snowflake Community Foundation, an Arizona non-profit and sole owner of the Apache Railway Company will be going to court today regarding their bankruptcy, in which the Creditor is trying to get the bankruptcy case dismissed. **Supervisor Whiting** indicated the public interest would be better served, by allowing the Foundation and the Railroad time and control to repay the Lender. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to adopt **Resolution Number 17-15**, supporting the continued operation of the Apache Railway Company; motion seconded by **Supervisor Whiting**. Vote unanimous approving the motion.

ADJOURN: At 9:04 a.m. **Supervisor Whiting made a motion** to adjourn; motion seconded by **Supervisor Williams**. Vote unanimous approving the motion.


