RESOLUTION R-2011-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TAYLOR, NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE INCLUSION OF TOWN OF TAYLOR AND TOWN OF SNOWFLAKE AS A “COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS” IN THE SAME COUNTY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Navajo County is currently developing new district boundaries to conform with County Guidelines, Federal Law and Department of Justice requirements; and

WHEREAS, The district boundaries must change to conform with the population changes as a result of the 2010 CENSUS; and

WHEREAS, Taylor and Snowflake were historically in the same district until the last redistricting of the County; and

WHEREAS, “Community of Interests” is to be considered under the redistricting guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Taylor and Snowflake are a “Community of Interests” as evidenced by the following shared services and interests:

1. Public Safety including Police and Ambulance Services
2. Education including K-12 and Post High School Education
3. Economic Interests including Chamber of Commerce, Economic Development Committees
4. Social and Recreational Interests including Senior Center, Library, Pool, Rodeo Grounds, Sports Leagues, etc
5. Transportation Planning and other Planning Issues
6. Other Shared Services and Interest


