

Option One

DEFENSIVE DRIVING CLASS (DDC)

You are eligible for the Defensive Driving Class if:

- You have not attended within the last year (violation date to violation date); and
- You **do not** contest your ticket; and
- You were cited for a moving civil violation not involving serious injury or death; and
- If an asterisk (*) is listed next to the violation on page 5; and
- You do not have a commercial driver's license.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING DEFENSIVE DRIVING CLASS (DDC)

1. If you choose to attend this course:

You must complete the course **SEVEN DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR COURT DATE**. Your court date is located on your ticket. **If you fail to appear at DDC before the court date, you are no longer eligible for defensive driving class.** You will then need to pay the fine and late fee in full.

NO EXTENSIONS WILL BE GRANTED.

- You may only attend a Supreme Court certified school. To register call **1-888-334-5565** or visit the website: **<http://www.azdrive.com>**
To attend an **out of state** school, you must register with an Arizona School at the number or website above.
- Please have your ticket with you when you register for the class.
- Follow the instructions provided by the Defensive Driving School. (Most schools will require you to provide your Driver's License, traffic ticket, and money order on the day you attend the class.)

DEFENSIVE DRIVING CLASSES ARE OFFERED STATE-WIDE.

Some schools offer online attendance.

****28-2354C LICENSE PLATE OBSTRUCTION:** First offense: \$164.00. Second offense: \$292.00.

****** 28-4135A-C VEHICLE INSURANCE:** A conviction of ARS 28-4135 (No Proof of Insurance) requires a mandatory fine and suspension of your license and registration. If you produce to the Court proof of insurance in effect at the time of violation, the charge will be dismissed. If you did not have insurance on the date of violation, the mandatory fine may be reduced and the elimination of suspension may occur if (1) you do not have prior convictions for no insurance (2) you provide the Court proof that you purchased a six month insurance policy; and (3) you provide a copy of your driving record from the Motor Vehicle Department or servicearizona.com. If you did not have insurance on the date of violation, please bring your proof of insurance and a copy of your driving record from the Motor Vehicle Department with you to court.

*******28-4139A SUSPENDED REGISTRATION PLATE:** (a) \$370.00 if reinstated vehicle registration and MVD receipt shown to court; or (b) \$607.00 if registration not reinstated; or (c) show proof from MVD to court if suspension is an MVD error.

+ 28-3169A, 28-2158 DRIVERS LICENSE OR VEHICLE REGISTRATION NOT IN POSSESSION: (a) Charge will be dismissed with proof of driver license or registration valid ON DATE AND TIME COMPLAINT WAS ISSUED. (b) \$227.00 if no proof.

++ 28-907A CHILD RESTRAINT SEAT
First Offense: Mail receipt proving purchase of child seat before your court date and there will be no fine.

+++28-645A3A RED LIGHT VIOLATIONS:
IMPORTANT NOTICE: If you have been cited for 28-645A3A, or are under age 18 (First Offense) and are found responsible at trial, you will be required to attend a traffic survival school (TSS) by the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD). If you are eligible for Defensive Driving Class and complete the class, the violation will be dismissed and you will not be subject to the TSS attendance noted above.

++++28-1177A&B OHV DECAL:
No fine with proof of current OHV decal.

++++EQUIPMENT VIOLATIONS:
First offense: Mail receipt proving compliance before your court date and there will be no fine .

For violations not listed, appear in court in person.

OPTION ONE

Attend a Defensive Driving Program. If you qualify, the following information applies to only one eligible charge. When you complete the course, you have no fine to pay, you do not have to appear in Court and no points will be placed on your driving record. See **Instructions for attending defensive driving class** on page two. (Commercial license not eligible.)

OPTION TWO

Admit the offense(s) on the ticket in three different ways. (a) Follow the INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYING THE FINE BY MAIL on page 3; (b) pay the fine at the service counter of the court between 8:00am and 4:30pm Monday through Friday (excluding holidays); or (c) appear in court on your court date.

OPTION THREE

Deny the offense on the ticket and request a hearing date in person or by mail. To deny the offense by mail, follow the instructions TO DENY THE OFFENSE AND REQUEST A HEARING on page 4.

NOTICE

If you fail to complete one of the three options above on or before the court date shown on a civil traffic ticket, the court will enter a default judgment against you. A civil sanction will be imposed, and your driver's license may be suspended until the civil sanction and late fees are paid to the court. If you are charged with a criminal offense, and fail to appear, your license will be suspended and you may be arrested.

CAN'T PAY THE FINE IN FULL?

A payment schedule may be arranged. Follow the instructions on page 3 paragraph 9.
