This guide is intended to assist residents in the proper way in discarding trash in a responsible manner, to reduce the amount of trash that is generated, to assist citizens in their efforts to prevent illegal dumping, and to also cleanup areas of concern within Navajo County.

Regulations and resources vary depending on where you live: within a town or city, within the unincorporated areas of Navajo County, or on a reservation.

Littering has become a major problem in Arizona and affects all of us. Not only is it ugly and blights our roadways and public areas, but it also harms our environment, pollutes our water, can promote disease, and offends the senses of established residents and visitors to our area.

Littering comes in many forms. It may be as simple as discarding a paper wrapper or a dirty diaper out of a car window, or as large as a truckload of garbage being dumped in a wash on private or public land. In all cases, littering – both big and small – is illegal and subject to prosecution and fines.

Garbage:

In the United States, we throw out 180 million tons of garbage each year, enough to bury 27,000 football fields in a layer of garbage ten feet deep.

Each and every day, approximately 250 tons of garbage and related waste is generated in Navajo County.

Most of this waste is collected and eventually delivered to one of several Transfer Stations throughout Navajo County. This waste is then transported to one of several area landfills.

What to do with Garbage

Garbage and waste should only be disposed of in an approved collection device for pickup by an approved collection company or Town/City.

For most of Navajo County, waste collection is provided by either a private collection company or by a town or city. For other areas, persons can bring their waste items directly to a Transfer Station.

This guide lists the appropriate disposal methods for every community within Navajo County.

What can be disposed of in the Garbage?

Generally speaking, food materials and biodegradable materials (such as paper & cloth) are best suited for disposal in the garbage. However, most paper products can also be recycled.

What can't?

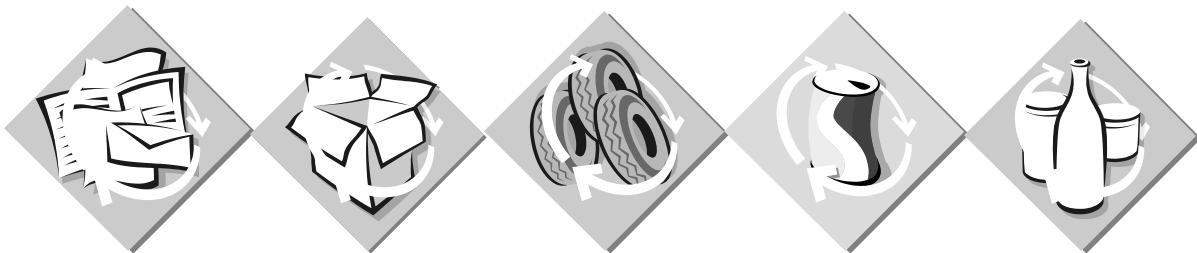
Also generally speaking, the following may not be disposed of in a trash can or dumpster, or at a Transfer Station:

- Tires. Tires can only be disposed of through a tire dealer or at a waste tire facility, such as the one maintained by Navajo County at the County Complex in Holbrook.
- Hazardous Wastes, such as batteries (including automotive batteries), paints, chemicals, etc.

What about the rest?

Many items are recyclable, including items made of paper, wood, metal (including aluminum), plastic, rubber, etc. Places that collect these materials are scattered throughout Navajo County, and are noted in the "Reduce, Reuse & Recycle" section of this Guide.

Although plant materials are not generally considered to be hazardous, they do take-up space in landfills, and are better off being shredded and composted, or taken to a facility designed for plant materials such as the Brush Pits and green waste disposal areas near Heber and Pinetop.

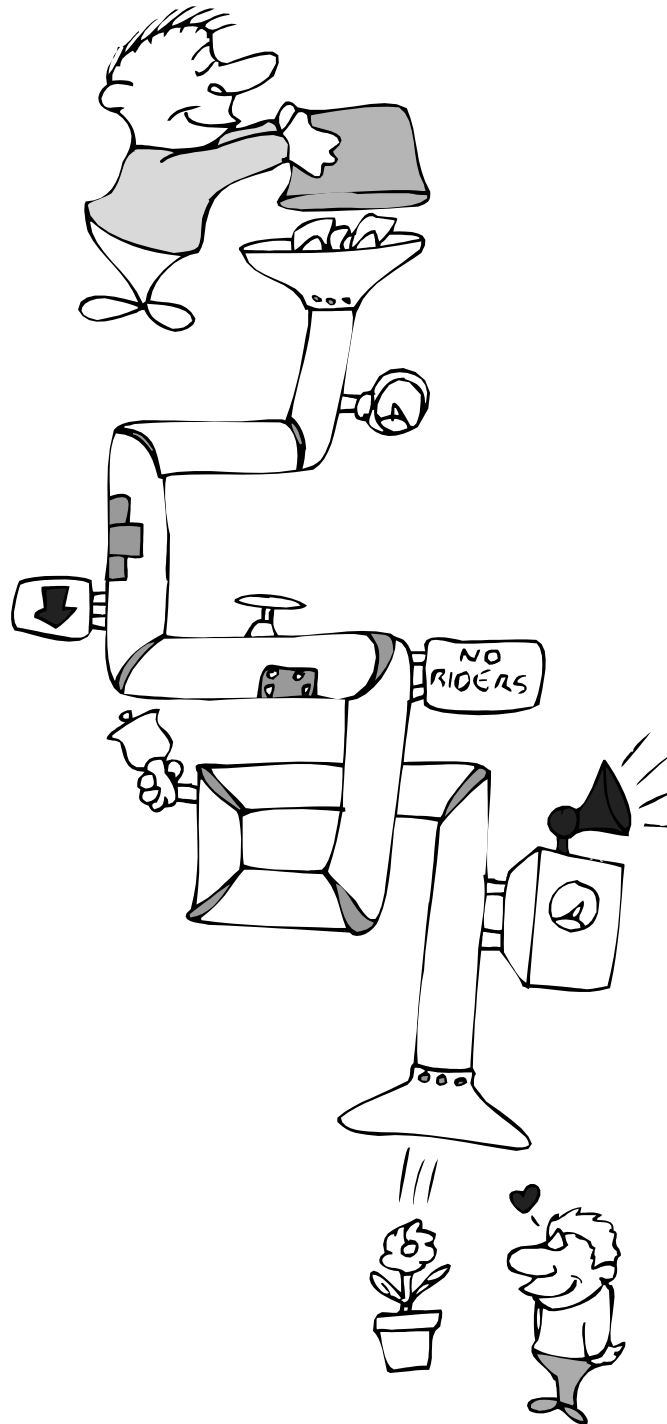

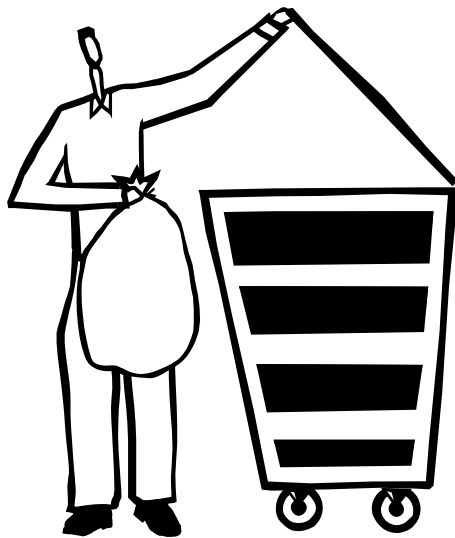

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

Reducing, reusing and recycling are the basis of a comprehensive waste reduction program. By preventing waste before it occurs, and by reducing waste through reuse and recycling, you will avoid disposal costs and save money.

Preventing waste is the easiest, most effective way to reduce your disposal costs. Often all you need to do to get started is to establish a few simple policies, then communicate those policies to employees.

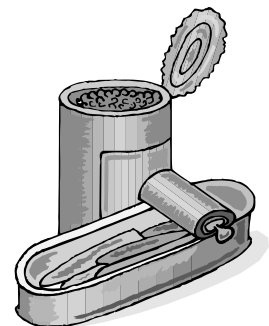

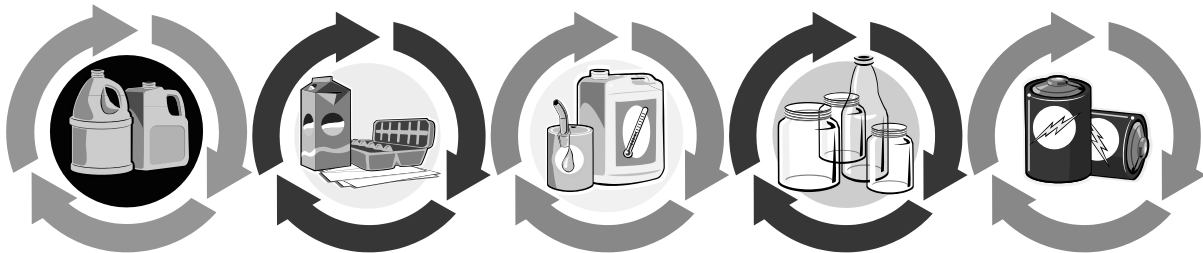

How You Can Help

Laws Applying to Illegal Dumping:

State Laws: ARS 13-1601, ARS 13-1602 and ARS 13-1603 define and regulate criminal littering and polluting. ARS 13-1601 defines “litter” to include any rubbish, refuse, waste material, offal, paper, glass, cans, bottles, organic or inorganic trash, debris, filthy or odoriferous objects, dead animals, or any foreign substance of whatever kind or description, including junked or abandoned vehicles, whether or not any of these items are of value.

ARS 13-1603 states that a person commits criminal littering or polluting if such person without lawful authority does any of the following:

- Throws, places, drops or permits to be dropped on public property, or property of another that is not a lawful dump, any litter, destructive material that he does not immediately remove.
- Discharges or permits to be discharged any sewage, oil products or other harmful substances into any waters or onto any shorelines within the state.
- Dumps any earth, soil, stones, ores or mineral on any land.

ARS 13-1603 also states the penalties for violating the above laws: A class 1 misdemeanor is punishable by a jail sentence of up to six months in the county jail. A fine may be imposed of up to \$2,500. A Class 6 felony is punishable by prison time of up to two years to the Department of Corrections. A fine may be imposed of up to \$150,000.

In addition, many federal, state, county, cities and town laws and ordinances regulate illegal dumping.

Navajo County also regulates illegal dumping and property cleanup. Contact the Navajo County Code Enforcement Division at 928-524-4114.

Illegal dumping can also be reported at 800-668-3867 (NOT-DUMP).

Cleanup Programs:

Many towns and cities sponsor local cleanups during the year. Please watch for notices of these in the local newspaper or contact your local town or city hall for more information.

Community Programs:

Many communities and neighborhood associations also sponsor local cleanups during the year. Please watch for these local announcements.

The Navajo County Code Enforcement Division also assists with community cleanup efforts. They can be reached at 928-524-4100.

Public Lands:

Navajo County has a significant amount of Public Lands, including the Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests, and vast areas of land that are owned by the State and Federal government. In addition, other State agencies, such as the Arizona Fish and Game Department, work hand-in-hand with private property owners and public agencies to protect natural resources and habitat for game and non-game species. These agencies appreciate local assistance in reporting illegal dumping and cleanup efforts. Their contact information is as follows:
