RESOLUTION OF PINON CHAPTER

The Pinon Chapter supports the Hopi Tribe in the planning, designing and constructing of Hopi Route (HR) 60, Low Mountain/Polacca Road, to make it all weather road.

WHEREAS:

1. The Pinon Chapter is recognized as a local government entity within the Navajo Nation Government promoting the interest and welfare of the constituents pursuant to Navajo Nation Code; and
2. The Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads has the fiduciary and trust responsibility to oversee that Navajo Reservations roads are safe for the general traveling public; and
3. The Hopi Route 60 connects the communities of District IV (Low Mountain, Whippoorwill, Blue Gap/Tachee, Pinon, Forest Lake and Hard Rock) and other chapters for public safety, schools and social services; and
4. The Pinon Chapter supports the paving of HR 60 in order for all schools to safely transport students to various border towns and metropolitan areas for field trips and support activities using HR 60 on a regular basis. During the inclement weather, the roads get very muddy and become impassable, which resulted in transporting students on pave road via Chinle and Ganado to get to the destination; and
5. The Pinon Chapter supports the plans for HR 60 to be all-weather so it could meet the needs of the general public to safely travel to nearby border town(s) to conduct businesses and seek medical attention.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


1. The Pinon Chapter hereby strongly supports the Hopi Tribe in their efforts planning and designing and their request for funds for constructing HR 60.




