

**NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES  
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2007**

**9:09 a.m.** Vice Chairman DeSpain acting as Chairman called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance and offered the invocation.

**PRESENT:** J. R. DeSpain, Vice-Chairman acting as Chairman; Percy Deal, Member; Jesse Thompson, Member; and Jerry Brownlow, Member; James Jayne, County Manager; and Darlene Fraley, Clerk of the Board. David Tenney, Chairman, was not present.

**CALL TO THE PUBLIC:** Supervisor Thompson led those present in singing happy birthday to J. R. DeSpain.

**CONSENT AGENDA:** a) Vouchers; b) Warrants over \$1,000: August, September; c) Letter of sympathy to Richard Garcia; d) Amendment #2 of WIA/DES Contract #DE070300001 to accept full funding of approved allocation from State WIA in the amount of \$304,807 increasing the previous contract funding level from \$127,359 to \$431,446; e) Amendment to Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement with US Department of Agriculture, Forest Service 03-LE-11030121-003 2008 Financial and Operating Plan to be in effect until September 2008; f) Grant-in-Aid Fiscal Agent Agreement between the Tohono O’odham Nation and Navajo County on behalf of the Pinetop Fire District; g) Minutes: August 7, August 14, September 4, September 11 and October 2, 2007; h) Clerk of Superior Court September report; i) Juvenile Justice System September report j) Justice Court reports: Holbrook #1 August; Winslow #2 July; Snowflake #3 August; Pinetop #6, August: Supervisor Thompson made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the items on the consent agenda; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.

**HUMAN RESOURCES:** Consideration and possible approval of Personnel Actions: Shalice Cook reviewed the 59 item written report advising that item 29 should read the “end of temporary appointment” rather than “end of probationary period.” **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to approve the Personnel Action Report as corrected and authorize the Chairman to sign that document; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.

**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

- a. Consideration and possible action to recommend approval of application for Liquor License #06090029 for Person Transfer – Location Transfer from Jack Lorenzo Young, Horsehead Crossing Saloon, 112 W. Bucket of Blood Street, Holbrook, AZ 86025 to Robert Brian Lambert, Strikes Alley, APN 206-02-012G, with business to be constructed at 2891 Highway 260, Overgaard, AZ: Deputy Clerk Lorinda Brown addressed the board advising this is a location/person transfer of liquor license for Strikes’s Alley to be constructed on the parcel as presented, stating that there were no objections raised from the departments and staff recommends approval. Mr. Lambert addressed the board stating they are building a bowling alley entertainment center in Overgaard and this liquor license would be used in that building. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to recommend approval of application for Liquor License #06090029 for a Person Transfer – Location Transfer from Jack Lorenzo Young, Horsehead Crossing Saloon, 112 W. Bucket of Blood Street, Holbrook, AZ 86025 to Robert Brian Lambert, Strikes Alley, APN 206-02-012G, with business to be constructed at 2891 Highway 260, Overgaard, AZ. Supervisors expressed concern about the responsible sale of liquor. Motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.
- b. Consideration and possible action to designate Vice-Chairman DeSpain as auctioneer during the October 16, 2007 land sale: **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to designate Vice-Chairman DeSpain as auctioneer during the October 16, 2007 land sale; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.

**NAVAJO COUNTY FAIR:** Informational report regarding the 2007 Navajo County Fair: Mina Henning, on behalf of the Fair Board thanked all entities in Navajo County for their assistance in making the fair successful and reported on revenue, attendance, increased participation in juvenile livestock and that GCPRA named Navajo County the largest in GCPRA rodeo in Arizona and New Mexico. There was some discussion on other scheduled events that conflict with the fair and ways to minimize their impact on fair attendance. Supervisors thanked Ms. Henning for her dedication.

**SHERIFF'S OFFICE:** Consideration and possible action to enter into a database agreement between the Navajo County Sheriff Office (NCSO) and the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) authorizing NCSO to receive motor vehicle records from MVD: Chief Deputy Bernard Huser advised the Sheriff's Office would like to enter into the data base agreement in an effort to expedite background processing on prospective employees. **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to enter into a database agreement between the Navajo County Sheriff Office (NCSO) and the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) authorizing NCSO to receive motor vehicle records from MVD; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.

**EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT:**

- a. Consideration and possible approval by Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07 naming Tim Zaremba as Navajo County applicant agent for all disasters: Tommy Price requested the board's authorization to make this change to reflect Tim Zaremba's responsibility. **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to rescind Resolution #47-05 appointing Larry Dunagan as applicant agent and approve **Resolution Number 77- 07** naming Tim Zaremba as Navajo County applicant agent for all disasters; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.
- b. Consideration and possible approval by Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07 declaring a local drought emergency: Mr. Price advised this action may open up drought related grant opportunities in the future. **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to approve **Resolution Number 78-07** declaring a local drought emergency; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.

**ELECTIONS:** Consideration and possible approval of Canvass of Official Results of the Silver Creek Flood Protection District #1 conducted October 3, 2007: Lisa McKee reviewed the official results of this election. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to approve the Canvass of Official Results of the Silver Creek Flood Protection District #1 conducted October 3, 2007; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.

**FINANCE:**

- a. Consideration and possible authorization for Finance to sell Joseph City Irrigation Company Water Shares at public auction: This item was continued.
- b. Consideration and possible award of contract to lowest responsible bidder to construct Mogollon Complex to Amon Builders, Inc. in the amount of \$1,031,000.00 not including any applicable taxes: Mary Springer advised the Mogollon Complex will be a shared complex to provide services to South County, expressing appreciation to County Engineer Jim Matteson and Public Works staff for their assistance on this project. Mr. Matteson reviewed the site, the square footage (8,459) of this building and the offices it will house. He advised Amon Builders was the lowest bidder, coming in well under the architect's estimate, reporting that the county had used this firm before. Mr. Parsons advised that this project is in response to one of the commitments made through Prop 400, providing a satellite facility that will provide most services to Heber-Overgaard area residents. He advised funding for this project comes from the Health District, Public Works and the General Fund. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to award the contract for IFB #B07-08-007 to construct the Mogollon Complex Inc. to Amon Builders as the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,031,000.00 not including any applicable taxes; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous

approving the motion.

- c. Consideration and possible award of contract to repair the jail roof to the lowest responsive bidder, Liberty Roofing, in the amount of \$32,131.46: Mary Springer requested support of this award to repair the jail roof utilizing Department of Corrections and Jail Enhancement funding. After some discussion, **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to award the repair of the jail roof to Liberty Roofing as the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$32,131.46; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.
- d. Consideration and possible award of contract to Design Modulars as the lowest responsive bidder to relocate NATC modular building from Glendale Community College to the NATC facility in Taylor: Mary Springer advised this award is to move the building that was already purchased. **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to award the contract to relocate the NATC modular building from Glendale Community College to the NATC facility in Taylor to Design Modulars as the lowest responsive bidder; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.

### **PUBLIC WORKS:**

- a. Consideration and possible authorization of funding to assist with a new van purchase and vehicle operating expenses for the Holbrook Senior Citizens Association from District III, LTAF II funds: Dusty Parsons advised the Senior Center is requesting \$9,600 as a matching grant to purchase a new van. There was discussion related to the use of LTAF II funds for operational expenses and Mr. Parsons stated he would research this. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to approve \$9,600 for a van for the Holbrook Senior Citizens' Center with funding to come from District III; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.
- b. North Whistle Stop Loop Improvement District: Carol Fraley advised that this district and the Mountain View Improvement District will not have the name "Road" in the district name even though it is for roads. She displayed a site map of the proposed district and reviewed the procedures in establishing an improvement district.
  - i. Consideration and possible action related to Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07 setting a hearing for November 6, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. for the formation of North Whistle Stop Loop Improvement District: **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to approve **Resolution Number 79-07** setting a hearing for November 6, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. for the formation of North Whistle Stop Loop Improvement District; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.
  - ii. Consideration and possible action to set the \$500.00 bond for the associate cost of the formation of this district: **Supervisor Deal made a motion** to set the bond at \$500.00 for the associated costs of the formation of this district; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.
- c. Mountain View Improvement District: Carol Fraley advised that all proper notices were mailed, publications were ordered, 79.59% property owners signed in favor of this district, and property owners of the total acreage of 79.8% signed in favor of the formation. Dusty Parsons and Jim Matteson discussed the properties within the area as being building lots and stated this was originally part of a much larger district and many did not want to participate
  - i. **PUBLIC HEARING on Formation of Mountain View Improvement District:** Vice-Chairman DeSpain opened the Public Hearing for this item. Wayne Evans, Dave Moreland and Robert Hemmings all spoke in favor of this project expressing appreciation for the board and staff's support. Vice-Chairman DeSpain called for objections and there were none. Vice-Chairman DeSpain closed the public hearing.
  - ii. Consideration and possible action related to Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07 establishing the Mountain View Improvement District of Navajo County: **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to approve **Resolution # 80 - 07** establishing the Mountain View Improvement District of Navajo County; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.

- d. **PUBLIC HEARING:** Consideration and possible action related to **Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07** to deny a Zone Change request by Gerald Perkins from A-General to Commercial-Residential for APN 208-14-19 in Township 11 North, Range 19 East, Section 15 of the Gila and Salt River Meridian in the Clay Springs area: Dusty Parsons requested that this item be tabled until the next meeting when Chairman Tenney could be in attendance.
- e. **PUBLIC HEARING:** Consideration and possible action related to **Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07** to deny a Zone Change request by Two Stars Trust from RU-20 to RU-5 for the subject property located at APN 303-18-565 in Township 14 North, Range 22 East, Section 30 of the Gila and Salt River Meridian in the Woodruff Ranch area: Telford Chapman reviewed this request and oriented the board to the site of this property between Woodruff and Snowflake off the old Woodruff Road. He reviewed the surrounding zoning and presented a site map showing the division of the property into four 5-acre lots plus the applicant retaining 16 acres. He advised the Planning & Zoning Commission voted 6-0 to recommended denial of this zone change and reviewed the staff report. Mr. Chapman advised he received letters from surrounding parcel owners who did not object to the zone change but there was a resident at the Commission meeting who did object. Dusty Parsons advised this is a request for spot zoning, which staff does not recommend; right now everyone around this owner has larger parcels. In reviewing the site map, he stated permitting this zoning would open all the other properties to similar splits. It was noted the owner of the property was aware of this hearing and chose not to attend. Mr. Fraley stated that the property owner was told initially that staff could not support this and historically the Commission and the Board have not supported this type of spot zoning. Vice-Chairman DeSpain invited comment for this public hearing and there was no response; he closed the hearing. Vice-Chairman DeSpain discussed difficulties that could arise by approving this spot zoning, stating he supports staff on this issue. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to approve **Resolution # 81 - 07** to deny a Zone Change request by Two Stars Trust from RU-20 to RU-5 for the subject property located at APN 303-18-565 in Township 14 North, Range 22 East, Section 30 of the Gila and Salt River Meridian in the Woodruff Ranch area; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.
- f. **PUBLIC HEARING:** Consideration and possible action related to **Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_ - 07** for a proposed Special Use Permit request by Robert & Patricia Erwin for APN 404-07-009C in Township 12 North, Range 22 East, Section 30 of the Gila and Salt River Meridian in the Shumway area: Telford Chapman displayed a site map showing the property where the proposed Bed and Breakfast is requested. He reviewed the staff report, displayed pictures of the property, and advised the Planning & Zoning Commission recommends approval of this action. At Supervisor Deal's request, Mr. Chapman reviewed the stipulations in the resolution. Bill Fraley and Telford Chapman reviewed the letters received regarding this issue. Vice-Chairman DeSpain advised this is a Public Hearing and invited comments. Patty Erwin, owner of the property, addressed the board providing her background and advising there would be only one guest per stay. With no other comments, Vice-Chairman DeSpain closed the hearing. **Supervisor Thompson made a motion** to approve **Resolution # 82 - 07** to include all stipulations for a proposed Special Use Permit request by Robert & Patricia Erwin for APN 404-07-009C in Township 12 North, Range 22 East, Section 30 of the Gila and Salt River Meridian in the Shumway area; motion seconded by Supervisor Deal; vote unanimous approving the motion.

Supervisor Thompson requested the Chairman go back to Call to the Public to give visitors time to address the board. Elmer Clark, a planner for the Dilkon Health Center employed under the Navajo Division of Health, Rosie Sekayumptewa of the Navajo County Health District and Leroy Thomas who represents the Southwest Navajo Nation District V and VII addressed the board discussing the Dilkon Health Center Steering Committee focus and area health care needs as well as a request for financial backing and the use of the expertise of county personnel in the planning process and lobbying efforts. Supervisor Thompson stated this center has moved up on the priority funding and staff would be meeting to determine technical assistance that can be provided.

**BOARD BUSINESS:** Supervisor Deal expressed frustration that the Department of Housing decided to disqualify all reservation CDBG projects after many years of funding them and requested this item be on a future agenda. He expressed disappointment that there has not been active county participation in the planning of the Indian Health Services' Hardrock Chapter mass vaccination exercise and expressed appreciation to the County Manager James Jayne and Dr. Kartchner for their willingness to meet to rectify this. He discussed the recent Kayenta Town Meeting where county employees and visiting dignitaries travelled to Kayenta for a meeting, stating that a letter and a check for that meeting were not included in the meeting materials resulting in embarrassment and requested more attention be paid to details in the future. He thanked Dusty Parsons and the Justice Court for their support during this meeting. No other supervisors reported.

At 11:55 a.m., the Board of Supervisors recessed for lunch.

**At 1:30 p.m.** Vice Chairman DeSpain opened the Navajo County 2007 Back Tax Land Auction, advising prospective purchasers that:

- All sales are final
- The bidder should seek advice on the marketability of title conveyed by Treasurer's Deed
- The bidder should examine property before purchasing
- The bidder should check the Assessor's map for location of the parcel
- No warranties or guarantees as to the size or condition of property
- No refunds will be made

He strongly encouraged bidders to pay heed to the above warnings, stating there can environmental issues, there may not be pins identifying the property and there may not be utilities to the property. He discussed the bidding process and introduced Manny Hernandez and staff from the County Treasurer's office. Vice-Chairman DeSpain gave those present the opportunity to ask questions regarding the properties and there were no questions. During the ensuing auction, all properties with the exception of 109-35-044B were sold.

At 3:09 a quorum reconvened with Supervisor Thompson, Vice-Chairman DeSpain, and Supervisor Deal present. Supervisor Brownlow was not present.

Consideration and possible action to deem all properties sold as auctioned: Vice-Chairman DeSpain advised several properties were bid at less than the minimum due and discussed the authority of the board to accept these offers. Treasurer Manny Hernandez presented a letter to the board advising he considered the \$25,000 bid on parcel 202-39-008 unacceptable requesting that the bid consider the taxes due of \$46,533.72 as a minimum acceptable purchase price. At Supervisor Deal's request this letter will remain on file in the Clerk's office as part of the permanent record. Following considerable discussion of all properties that were bid under the minimum due, **Supervisor Deal made a motion** that this board sell, with the exception of APN 202-39-008, all properties that were underbid for the minimum due with those who bid less than minimum offered the first right of refusal on their properties; the exception property, APN 202-39-008, to be offered for \$46,533.72; all unsold properties to be listed on the ongoing property list; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson; vote unanimous approving the motion.

At 3:50 p.m. Supervisor Deal made a motion to adjourn; motion seconded by Supervisor Thompson. Vote unanimous approving the motion.
