

**NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' MINUTES**  
**\*SPECIAL MEETING\***  
**FRIDAY, JULY 1, 2011**

**PRESENT:** J.R. DeSpain, Vice Chairman is present in the Board Chambers; David Tenney, Chairman; Jesse Thompson, Supervisor; Jerry Brownlow, Supervisor are present.

**5:09 p.m. Call To Order:** Supervisor DeSpain opened the Special Meeting and indicated that he will allow the public to make public comments.

Ken Flowberg addressed the Board in opposition of granting the application for fireworks. Sherry Lloyd spoke in favor of the application.

**EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT:**

- a. Report of current fire restrictions and possible reconsideration of Heber/Overgaard commercial fireworks permit: Dusty Parsons gave a report of the current fire restrictions. Mr. Parsons explained that the weather is an extreme wind of 97% and recommended denying the permit. Supervisor DeSpain indicated that Sheriff Clark supports the decision. Chairman Tenney thanked everyone for being present and commented on the fireworks display in the Heber/Overgaard area. He further indicated that he supports the decision of the Sheriff and Mr. Parsons; however he does feel that we should review our Ordinance at a later time to allow local fire chiefs to review. Supervisor Brownlow indicated that he agrees with the recommendation. Supervisor Thompson also supports the recommendation due to dry weather conditions. Supervisor DeSpain indicated that we can look at the Ordinance at a later date. Dusty made further comments. **NO ACTION.**
