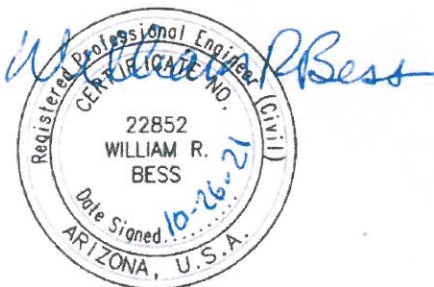
RE: B21-09-001, Suppling Barbed Wire Fencing, Addenda No. 1

Replace Special Provisions page SP-1 with SP-1 (Revised 10/25/20221). The first and second sentence of "1. Scope of Work" has been revised to read two geographical areas instead of six geographical areas:

1. **Scope:** This is an invitation for proposals to perform the supply and installation of barbed wired fencing in rights-of-way in two geographic areas in Navajo County for "**Supplying Barbed Wire Fencing, Contract #B21-09-001**". Each bidder must submit a proposal for the areas listed on the bid schedule, but Navajo County may award separate contracts for each geographic area. This will be a one-year contract to provide barbed wire fencing at the contract price on an as-needed basis. **Quantities in the contract documents are estimates only.** The Contractor will be required to complete each project during the year within 30 days after Navajo County issues a Notice to Proceed.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

These Special Provisions shall supersede the General Conditions and the working specifications where there is a conflict.

1. **Scope:** This is an invitation for proposals to perform the supply and installation of barbed wired fencing in rights-of-way in two geographic areas in Navajo County for "**Supplying Barbed Wire Fencing, Contract #B21-09-001**". Each bidder must submit a proposal for the areas listed on the bid schedule, but Navajo County may award separate contracts for each geographic area. This will be a one-year contract to provide barbed wire fencing at the contract price on an as-needed basis. **Quantities in the contract documents are estimates only.** The Contractor will be required to complete each project during the year within 30 days after Navajo County issues a Notice to Proceed.
2. **Multiple Awards:** It is the intent of the Owner to award a primary and a secondary contract in each geographic area. If the primary Contractor is not able to perform the specified work in the particular area when a Notice to Proceed is issued, the secondary Contractor will be given the Notice to Proceed, at no cost to the primary, but without any compensation to the primary. If the primary accepts a Notice to Proceed and fails to complete the work in a timely manner, the secondary will be given a Notice to Proceed, and the difference in price will be deducted from any amount due to the primary. If the primary Contractor fails to start after a Notice to Proceed has been accepted, a Notice to Proceed will then be issued to the secondary Contractor with the entire costs being assessed against the Performance Bond. **Performance and Payment Bonds will be required for each individual project and each Notice to Proceed.**
3. **Scheduling:** The County shall provide the Contractor with as much notice as possible, but not less than fourteen (14) days, prior to the desired material receipt date. The County reserves the right to negotiate with other suppliers if, in the County's opinion, the material is needed immediately and/or there is an unreasonable delay in providing the material if the material does not meet specifications.
4. **Prosecution and Progress:** When the contract time is on the calendar day basis, it shall consist of the number of calendar days specified, including Saturdays, Sundays, and Legal Holidays.
5. **Changes in the Work:** No changes shall be made by the Contractor without a signed written Change Order from the County Engineer, approved by the Navajo County Board of Supervisors, as necessary, except in an emergency endangering life and property.
6. **Price:** Prices given on this bid shall be effective for a period of one (1) year from the day of the bid award. Navajo County intends to award the contract to the responsible bidder(s) whose bid conforms to the invitation and whose bid is the most advantageous to the County concerning price, conformity to the specifications, and other factors. **Bids shall include all applicable taxes.** Material shall be bid per lineal foot installed.
7. **Payments:** The accepted products, supplied as provided in the specifications, will be paid for upon delivery at the contract unit price awarded by the Board of Supervisors. Payment shall constitute full compensation for supplying and delivering the units to the designated road yards. Payment shall be in accordance with A.R.S. §34-221. Invoices shall be
