Navajo County Rural Addressing is in accordance with County Ordinance 01-88. Navajo County Rural Addressing will attempt to address all requests. To facilitate this request please include any legal information regarding accesses. Such as plat maps, recorded easements, recorded agreements, or deed describing an easement as part of this application. If no proof of legal access is evident, then an address may not assignable.

If a lot is a corner lot, please include which road will be the main point of access. If parcel is vacant, please included a copy of this addressing form to the buyers. If a different access is used from the addressed access, a new address maybe required.

Should a property be split, Navajo County Rural Addressing will attempt to keep a structure with original address but cannot guarantee that the structure will assume original address.

When an access is used by two or more structures, an application may take longer as the access will have to be named and approved by the Board of Supervisors. Property owners may request names to be used. If there are more than 1 property owners then a petition may be required to show support of using a particular name by all directly affected property owners.
